The building, erected in 1929 by Millars Timber & Trading Company, displays the unique quality of both timber and workmanship of that time. Restored to its former splendour, timber products dominate the building with ornate designs of panelling, timber columns and beams with elaborate fireplace surrounds and beautiful glass panelled doors.

GATES	Open and close Monday to Friday 7am – 9pm, and by arrangement on weekends and public holidays or for events
PARKING	Free on ground parking close to the entrance
CATERING	On site catering (food & beverage) arrangements are to be made with the Royal Agricultural Society
